As an educational ministry, Mukhanyo promotes mission and evangelism. We believe **the Bible is the foundation for all of faith and life**. This programme provides a **systematic introduction to major areas of theological study, including both academic study and practical application of biblical truth**. This three and a half year programme (28 modules) is designed as a foundational programme for church leaders.

South Coast Bible School will facilitate and administer this program in the following manner:

- The program will run as a **one-week** resident Bible School Course **four times per year**.
- **Requirements: Matric certificate; Read, write and speak English.** (All lectures are presented in English and all assignments / examinations need to be submitted in English.)
- Only **one intake** will take place every four years. So, apply now for the 2017 intake.
- Cost: **R800-00 per week** including notes; accommodation and food.
- Bring your own bedding, toiletries, note pad, pens, Bible, etc.
- **Closing date** for application is **10th of January 2017**.
- **R400-00** to be paid with your application.

Please note the following:

- ❖ This program has a **high academic standard** so you need to come prepared to study!
- ❖ Only **serious students** will be accepted.
- ❖ You need to be in **good standing with your local church** and approved for studies by your Pastor. Regular feedback and interaction with you and your Pastor will be required to help you grow in ministry.
- ❖ Students need to **arrive on Sunday evening** for classes as all examinations will be taken on Sunday evenings.
