List of Courses studied over 3 years

- Course 1 - Matthew's Gospel.** Study of the Life of Jesus, examining his teaching, training of the 12; His trial, crucifixion, resurrection & ascension. 12 hours
- Course 2 - The Sunday School & How to teach.** How to organise and improve a Sunday School, with a view to growth; how to prepare and teach a Sunday School class. 12 hours
- Course 3 - Philippians.** Paul's joy in Christ. 5 hours
- Course 4 - Old Testament History/Survey I.** Creation and the beginnings of mankind. Noah, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph and Moses (Genesis to Deuteronomy). 12 hours
- Course 5 - Doctrine of Man, Sin & Salvation.** What the Bible teaches About Man created innocent in God's image, his fall into sin, the nature of Sin, the way of Salvation: faith, repentance, justification, redemption, re-birth, sanctification. 12 hours
- Course 6 - Psalms.** A look at a selection of Psalms that help us in our walk with God. 5 hours
- Course 7 - John's Gospel.** The purpose of John - "that you may believe..." A study of the "I Am's" of Christ; the "Upper-room discourse"; His Death, resurrection and appearances. 14 hours
- Course 8 - Doctrine of Christ.** A study of the person of Jesus Christ - His humanity and his deity. A study on the meaning and importance of Christ's atoning death; His resurrection and ministry in heaven. 9 hours
- Course 9 - Daniel.** The challenge of Daniel's life. 6 hours
- Course 10 - New Testament Survey.** Brief survey of each of the 27 books: Their relationships to each other, writer, date, circumstances, purpose and important themes. 12 hours
- Course 11 - Evangelism and Discipleship.** The presentation of the Gospel; Crusade and Personal Evangelism; Steps in leading a soul to Christ; Helping a seeker to overcome barriers; Encouraging the new believer to grow in faith, worship, obedience and service. 12 hours
- Course 12 - Book of Esther.** God preserves His people. The courage of a woman of God. 5 hours
- Course 13 - Acts.** The birth and growth of the Church. The work of the Holy Spirit in the lives of believers like Peter, Phillip, Stephen and Paul. The missionary journeys of Paul and his final trip to Rome. 11 hours

- Course 14 - Doctrine of the Holy Spirit.** Studies of the Spirit as a Person; His deity; His baptism; the fullness of the Spirit; His gifts and fruit. 10 hours
- Course 15 - Missions.** What the Bible teaches about missions and what God wants from His church today. 8 hours
- Course 16 - Old Testament History/Survey II.** The history of the Jewish people from Joshua through to Esther. The five books of Poetry. 12 hours
- Course 17 - Doctrine of God and Angels.** Nature of God; His Names and Attributes. The Trinity. Angels - good and bad, including Satan. 12 hours
- Course 18 - Isaiah.** His call. The messianic prophecies. 5 hours
- Course 19 - 1 Corinthians.** A study of how Paul helped a weak church with many problems. 10 hours
- Course 20 - Ethics.** Biblical teaching on principles of determining right behaviour. Christian relationship to O.T. Law; Marriage; Divorce; Abortion; African Traditional Practices.
Church Administration. Biblical teaching on Church Government; Leaders of Local Church; How to improve efficiency, Finance. 14 hours
- Course 21 - Joshua.** The Victorious Christian Life. 5 hours
- Course 22 - Church Principles.** Direct Lordship of Christ, authority of Scripture, Priesthood of all believers, etc.* **Stewardship.** Living the responsible life, caring for God's things, Giving. 14 hrs
- Course 23 - 1 Timothy; Pastoral Ministry & Church Growth.** Study of 1 Timothy as related to work of a Pastor. Visitation and Counselling. His public ministry. His family. Principles of church growth. 10 hrs
- Course 24 - Exodus.** Deliverance from slavery and the Christian's relationship to the Ten Commandments. 5 hours
- Course 25 - Romans.** A study of Paul's presentation of the basic teachings on the Gospel, emphasising chapters 1 – 8. 10 hours
- Course 26 - Other Religious Systems.** Evaluation of teachings of Jehovah Witnesses, Mormons, Seventh Day Adventists, Roman Catholics, Liberals, Zionists, Animists, Islam, Hinduism, Excessive Practices. 10 hours
- Course 27 - Spiritual Disciplines.** Developing the key spiritual disciplines that a follower of Christ has to cultivate. Preparing leaders. 10 hours

- Course 28 - Old Testament Survey III.** Evaluating the lives of David and Solomon, along with their contemporaries. What went right and wrong during the time of these kings? 10 hours
- Course 29 - How to Study the Bible (Hermeneutics).** The inductive Bible study method. How to interpret Scripture and make accurate application. 10 hours
- Course 30 - Biblical Leadership** How to lead, following a Biblical model of leadership laid down in books like Nehemiah and Joshua. 10 hours
- Course 31 - Ephesians.** God's electing grace. They mystery that Jews and Gentiles are reconciled in the Body of Christ, the Church. The Gifts of the Spirit. Our Spiritual warfare. 8 hours
- Course 32 - How to Preach (Homiletics).** The preacher. Different types of sermons. How to find a theme, prepare and outline, illustrate and apply. Each student will prepare and practice. 16 hours
- Course 33 - Jeremiah.** His call. His suffering and disappointments. His faithfulness. The New Covenant promised. 5 hours
- Course 34 - Revelation.** John encourages a persecuted and discouraged church to stand firm because Christ will conquer every enemy when he brings us into His Eternal Kingdom. Future events examined. 12 hours
- Course 35 - Doctrine & History of the Church.** What is the Church? A brief study of the N.T. Church and her history from apostolic to modern times with emphasis on the failures and errors we must avoid today and the revivals that can encourage us now. 12 hours
- Course 36 - Nehemiah.** Victorious Christian leadership studied as we learn of Nehemiah's inspiring God's people to rebuild Jerusalem's walls. 5 hours
